HHA PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Homestead Neighbors!

Fall is finally here and with that, shorter days, cooler temperatures, and fall plantings. The HOA missed its opportunity to update the medians in the spring due to needed upgrades in our sprinkler controllers, but with the cooler weather you will see that the medians and entrances are getting enhancements and new plantings.

Southern Botanical also completed trimming of the trees at our entrance to allow better light penetration for ground plantings. Southern Botanical continues to work on eliminating the Dallis Grass.

In the fall, the clubhouse will be decorated with pumpkins and other Fall decorations. We hope you like it and can take the opportunity to have some pictures taken in front of the clubhouse. After Thanksgiving, we will be decorating the neighborhood with holiday lights with some lighting on the clubhouse and at the front entrance.

We will be closing the pool by the 6th of October this year, which comes after the yearly National Night Out. By then, the temperatures will be cooler and pool usage will drop dramatically.

There will be a Manly Men event at the clubhouse on Friday, November 1st and the Annual Fall Festival will be held at Primrose Park on Sunday, November 10th.

We thank all of the homeowners who have attended the past few board meetings and encourage as many of you as possible to attend. Your participation ensures that the board is hearing you as directly as possible and also helping to ensure that you understand why some decisions are made that might not come out in the meeting minutes.

The HOA is working to complete its updated budget for next year and we hope to have that approved at our October meeting. At this time, we do not foresee any need for a rate increase. Rates have been the same for the past 2 years.

The City of Carrollton has notified us that they will be inspecting our neighborhood beginning on October 2, 2013 for code compliance. As part of that, the city will also be focusing on tree compliance in alleys and streets to ensure that they are at 12 foot clearance over streets and 7 foot clearance over sidewalks. This will not focus on tree removal. Other neighborhoods will be inspected at different times throughout the year. 
